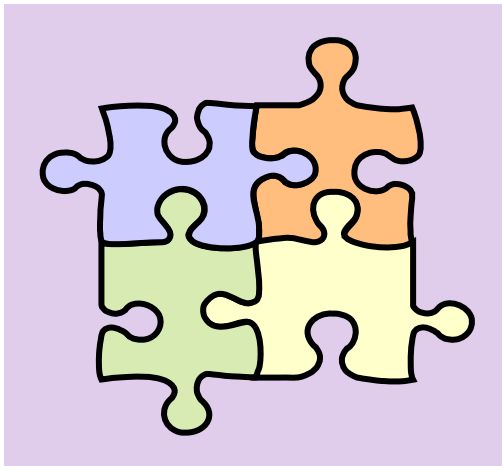

## PROGRAM SET

**LD5374 Christianity Across Cultures:** Delve into interactive discussions with real-life case studies of Christians in different cultures. What would you do in their situation?

**LD5372 Social and Political Organization:** Learn how to do field interviews by applying the “Grid-Group” theory. This interactive course will help you process using these interview and analysis techniques in your own context.

**LD5321 Multicultural Teamwork:** Learn the way that differences in culture, values and expectations, affect teamwork and how to work together with others in a common cause.

**LD5323 Multicultural Leadership:** Learn the characteristics of a good leader working with multiple cultures and those qualities in the Bible that are universal.
